# "Grants To Teachers" 2019-2020 INFORMATION

#### What is the "Grant To Teachers" Program?

The Newport Mesa Schools Foundation provides funds to "certificated" teachers or school personnel in the Newport Mesa Unified School District to purchase or produce materials for programs and projects that are creative, innovative and responsive to student needs. Through fundraising efforts and donations to the NMSF, we are able to present funds directly to the teacher or personnel to implement their program during the current school year. The NMSF is the only district-wide foundation to award qualified grant funding to all schools that apply.

To Date, the Newport Mesa Schools Foundation has donated well over \$7 Million.

### How many grants can I apply for?

N-MUSD Certified School Personnel may apply for (1) one Grant, per year.

#### What is the maximum amount of funding that I can ask for?

An applicant may request funding up to \$1,000. Maximum

## What categories are available for grant writing? NMSF Offers (9) Nine Categories:

## NOTE: Technology Grant Applications: (hardware and software)

Before writing your technology grant application, you must clear it through your <u>School Administrator</u>, and <u>N-MUSD</u> IT/ET DEPT. The technology must be supported by the District Guidelines.

#### How are grant applications selected for funding?

NMSF members recruit 65 community members representing educational, professional, civic, and non-profit sectors of our community to form 10 "Grant Reader Groups". Grant readers read, critique, and score each grant application without the knowledge of the applicant's name, school, or zone.

(NMSF board members do not score grant applications.)

#### Funding Applications are based on the following criteria:

- ✓ Concise, well-defined plan and implementation of your educational objectives and costs.
- ✓ Benefits and number of students this plan will serve, & provides interdisciplinary experiences in any subject.
- ✓ Applicant has adhered to all application instructions and requirements.
- ✓ Applicant has provided a correct funding total for all requested budgetary items.

Mid-December, the NMSF Board will let you know, in writing, through district mail if your grant application will be funded or not.

4. <u>Submit Receipt Form</u>, attach all <u>purchase receipts</u>, and send to the NMSF Office no later than <u>May 31<sup>st</sup></u>.

Failure to submit receipts will result in disqualification from next year's grant program

### Regulations on the ownership of all grant materials:

All grant materials & equipment are the property of N-MUSD and will <u>remain with the grantee</u> (teacher/school personnel) until his/her retirement, resignation, etc. The grant materials & equipment will then <u>remain at the school site</u> where the recipient last taught.
